### Recreation Department Summary for November 2013/December 2013

#### ***Building Usage:***

The Wildwood Recreation Center hosted a total of **1,134 Fitness Room Members**, approximately **1,486 Recreation Members**.

#### ***Daily Usage Total:***

The combined total daily usage for the recreation center from 11/19/13 to 12/16/2013 was approximately **2,620** people.

#### ***Meetings – Special Event Usage/Use of Facilities:***

***NAACP Group*** – We will allow them to hold a total of two meetings in here per year. They are supposed to get me the dates that they want with the first meeting being in February sometime. I will keep everyone posted. We still need to look at our by-laws and make sure we have some sort of guidelines we follow for groups using the facility for a meeting place like this and institute something if nothing is there.

#### ***Programs this Winter:***

1. **Arena Football** – sign ups went well, we had well over 80 kids grades 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> (boys and girls) sign up. We have 8 teams which play games every Friday night starting Friday, January 10<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup> with the playoffs going into March. See attached schedule.
2. **Indoor Soccer** – sign ups went well for both leagues 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade leagues. We have 4 teams in each league so again over 80 kids (boys and girls), which play games every Sunday morning starting Sunday, January 12<sup>th</sup> thru Sunday, February 16<sup>th</sup> with playoffs going into early March. See attached schedule.
3. **Half Pint Basketball** – sign ups went well. We ended up with six teams and over 60 combined boys and girls grades K-2<sup>nd</sup> which play games every Saturday morning starting Saturday, January 11<sup>th</sup> thru Saturday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>. This league doesn't have playoffs. See Attached schedule.
4. We started Kung Fu classes again and this class is free of charge for any kids wanted to participate. Numbers are low which is why we are offering the class for free.


