2. Seafood and Music Festival – Discussion was held on some issues that arose with regard to electricity. There is not enough power at the Schellenger Avenue end; this is an issue every year. Ultimately, it was decided that it is not a power issue but one of distribution of vendors. Further discussion was held on vendor fees and what they encompass; extending the festival by length of hours, additional days and in street length.
3. Gentlemen's Race – Overall, this event was a success for a first time event. Some internal modifications need to be made going forward. The race is the talk of the racing industry and Hot Rod Magazine and other on-line publication have shown an interest. Esquire Network has shown interest in televising the event next year. It was a good weekend and the weather cooperated.
