1. Amateur Boxing

Discussion was held on the history of the Boxing Club building. The building, located at Garfield Avenue & Park Boulevard, was formerly a transmission shop. It was cleaned up and turned over to the Boxing Club. The Club is a non-profit organization, is run entirely by volunteers and is open 5 days a week. Anyone wishing to box must get a physical and sign up with USA Boxing.

Mr. Eye provided his background and experience in boxing. A very extensive discussion was held on amateur boxing vs. professional boxing events, indoor

vs. outdoor events, attendance, weekly vs. monthly events, tickets sales and the cost to produce a boxing event.

Mr. Trivelis explained how the TDC funding works, with the funding going towards advertising and Ms. Trapp explained how the GWTIDA funding works. Ms. Trapp arranged for the group to meet with John Lynch, Director of Sales at the Convention Center, that afternoon. They will discuss the availability of the hall and seek funding from GWTIDA.
