**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

A. Maxwell Field Playground - The Press Box looks phenomenal. Some work still needs to be done. Plaques will be installed on the Press Box in memory of classmates of Wildwood High School.

The playground still has holes from the playground equipment. Public Works will send someone over to move the dirt. Once that is done, it will be seeded.

B. Hours of Operation - We still have issues with staffing of part-timers. When the school is closed and so is the Rec, the children have nowhere to go. Mr. Hans may try modified hours with the part-timers.

- C. Memo to the Mayor regarding Fox Park Responsibilities - We are still waiting on information relating to who is responsible for Fox Park since the current employee overseeing the park is a Public Works employee and does not report to Mr. Hans. Mr. Troiano will seek further clarification.
- D. Football - The football program is up and running. We have 90 kids signed up and 30 cheerleaders. Children from all the towns on the island are participating in the program. North Wildwood purchased shoulder pads. The first game is this week. Local businesses have sponsored signs around the field at anywhere from \$500.00 to \$1,000.00 per sign. We are very short on coaching staff.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. Tennis Net - The school purchased a net and asked the city to install, which it did.
- B. Tennis Court - There is a large crack running down the Montgomery side of the court from Atlantic Avenue to Ocean Avenue. A student rolled their ankle because of the conditions. The damage to the court was caused by Super Storm Sandy, so Mr. Hans will speak with the Wildwood Office of Emergency Management to see if FEMA may provide funds to repair the damage. A replacement court could have a life expectancy 25 years.
