NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Maxwell Field Open Space - Discussion was held on the grant to redo the fields with turf. This will enable us to host tournaments, generate income, it will be less wear and tear, we can move the Fox Park ball field to the Recreation Center, eliminates water with not having to fertilize or irrigate. The field comes in tiles and you can replaced tiles as wear and tear occurs.
- B. Soccer Tournament - A request was made by the alumni of Roman Catholic to hold a soccer tournament on July 22nd from 10:00 .m. to 03:00 p.m. They will be charged a fee of \$50.00.
- C. Soccer Camp - Soccer Shots, out of Barnegat, NJ, requested to run a one week camp. They want to charge by camper. There will be a couple of sessions per day with 16 children and 36 adults instructing. These will be a couple of different age groups. Mr. Hans is going to look into how they are running and charging for the camp before a decision is made.
- D. Color Guard - the will be using the facilities again this year from May 3rd to May 7th; 40 hours of rental, which generates \$4,000.00 in income.
